SCRIPT - Windows 10, the Painful Upgrade

Adrian:

Hardy:

Hardy:

May I ask how this upgrade was painful?

Adrian:

Microsoft forcibly upgraded the laptop using windows update and without my approval!

Hardy:

I did read an article in a computer magazine that Microsoft was forcing its windows 7 and 8.1 users to windows 10, but this is a completely different issue

Adrian:

I have more problems

Hardy:

Go on...

Adrian:

I keep having loads of junk loaded on to my computer

Hardy:

Can I have a look into this

Adrian:

Go on...

Adrian passes the laptop to Hardy

Hardy:

I see. It has gone into the blue screen of death this time

Adrian:

Great, I did not have this problem before the upgrade

Hardy:

Don't worry my computer repair man can fix this

Hardy calling Jon

Hardy:

Jon

Jon enters the shop from the workshop

Jon:

What can I do for you Hardy?

Hardy:

A Laptop needs fixing

Jon:

And what operating system

Adrian:

Windows 10 Home Premium

Jon:

I shall see what I can do

Hardy passes the laptop to Jon and heads to the workshop

Adrian:

I do hope Jon knows what he is doing?

Hardy:

He was an expert in repairing computers since the days of Windows 98

Adrian:

Good, I in safe hands

Jon returns from the workshop

Jon: Hardy, looks like this laptop has being fixed

Hardy:

Good.

Adrian:

And how much will the repair cost?

Hardy:

£160 repair charge plus a £50 per 30 minute labour charge

Adrian:

A bit expensive, I hope the repair is worth it

Adrian turns on the laptop

Adrian:

My Laptop has now crashed

Hardy:

Strange, I shall get Jon to fix this, Jon

Jon enters the shop from the workshop

Jon:

What do you want this time?

Hardy:

Try and fix the laptop again please

Jon:

But I just fixed it

Hardy:

Well go and fix it again

Hardy passes the laptop to Jon again and Jon heads to the workshop

Adrian:

You told me that Jon was an expert

Hardy:

I did tell you he fixes computers from the days of windows 98 to windows 8.1, but this was his first time use of windows 10.

Adrian:

So what was he up to?

Hardy:

Trying to reinstall windows 10 from a clean install

Adrian:

Great, I now have a laptop that doesn't work, the service your computer shop has is terrible, what are you going to do about it?

Hardy:

Well we could reinstall Windows 7 back on the computer, Jon can fix Windows 7

Jon Returns

Jon:

Hardy, I still can't get the laptop fixed

Adrian:

So what can we do this time?

Hardy:

Jon, could you reinstall another copy of Windows 7 onto the laptop

Jon:

I shall try

Jon Heads back into the workshop

Adrian:

So what did you ask Jon to do?

Hardy:

Simple, I asked Jon to reinstall Windows 7 as he can fix Windows 7 computers

Jon Returns

Jon:

Hardy, I reinstalled Windows 7 but the laptop is still booting to Windows 10

Hardy:

What else can you do?

Jon:

I could do a complete reinstall of Windows 7 and clear out Windows 10 completely

Hardy:

Get on with it

Jon:

Ok

Jon Heads back to the workshop

Adrian:

I hope Jon gets the laptop in one piece

Hardy:

I hope so, Jon is good at fixing laptops so this one will be an easy repair

Adrian:

An easy repair!

Jon Returns with the laptop

Jon:

The Laptop is now working again

Hardy: So that will be another £160 with £50 per 30 minutes labour charge

Adrian:

Another repair charge! It better be worth it

Adrian Checks the laptop

Adrian:

Well I can see that it now has Windows 7 installed and the laptop is now working properly

Hardy:

Good, if you find any more problems, give us a ring

Adrian:

Said too soon, it's reinstalling Windows 10 again
