SCRIPT: Mastermind Spoof

Harvey: Good evening and welcome to another edition of Mastermind with myself Harvey Magnusson and tonight these two contestants go head to head for the title of Mastermind Champion of 2016. The aim of the game is to get as many correct answers as possible, with the fewest passes. And if they don't know an answer to a question, then they must say pass. I can then move on to the next question. So can the first contestant please come forward.

Contestant takes to the chair – Background changes from pink to a black background

- Harvey: And your name please?
- **Cont.1:** My Name is (Contestant's name), I'm at South Leicestershire College and my chosen subject is Donald Trump 2016
- Harvey: You have one minute and thirty seconds on your chosen subject of Donald Trump. And if you don't know an answer to a question, then you must say pass so I can move on to the next question. So do you understand?
- Cont.1: I do understand
- Harvey: In 2007, Donald Trump was linked as a witness for the defence on the court case in Canada, for which person?
- Cont.1: But wasn't my subject focusing on 2016? This question is from 2007
- Harvey: Just answer the question
- Cont.1: Maybe Conrad Black
- Harvey: Correct
- Harvey: Which newspaper accused the BBC of only interviewing Hillary Clinton supporters?
- **Cont.1:** Could you repeat the question
- Harvey: I can't repeat it, I just need an answer
- Cont.1: Pass

Harvey:	Donald Trump predicted that if he won the US election, he would compare it to which recent political event in the UK?
Cont.1:	But I did choose the Subject of Donald Trump and only Donald Trump
Harvey:	Just answer the question and stop wasting time
Cont.1:	The UK voting to leave the EU
Harvey:	No, it was Brexit+++
Harvey:	During the Brexit court case, the cameras cut to the dog with the EU flag before focusing on the cartoon of which political leader?
Cont.1:	Are you sure you are on topic here? That question is now on Brexit
Harvey:	But I thought Donald Trump was a fan of Brexit
Cont.1:	Can you stick to the subject
Harvey:	Just answer the question and stop wasting your time
Cont.1:	Nigel Farage
Harvey:	Correct
Harvey:	Which Conservative MP was highly in favour of the leave campaign during the EU Referendum?
Cont.1:	You're getting off topic again! Most of these questions are not on my chosen subject
Harvey:	But these are the questions that were given to me before the show started, so stop wasting your time and give me an answer
Cont.1:	Good thing I did look this one up online just in case, I think it is Boris Johnson
Harvey:	Correct
Harvey:	One of Donald Trumps
The End bleeps cut Harvey off	

Harvey: I've started, so I will finish

- Harvey: One of Donald Trump's key policy's was to build a wall to which country?
- **Cont.1:** Finally a question in my subject
- Harvey: You do realise that I need an answer before I time you out
- Cont.1: Mexico
- Harvey: Correct, and we now come to the end of your round and with four correct answers, one incorrect answer and one pass for which I will tell you the answer was The Daily Express, you end the round with four points

Background changes back to pink

Contestant 1 returns to the seats

Harvey: Next Contestant please

Contestant 2 takes to the chair

Harvey: And your name

- **Cont.2:** My name is (contestants name) I'm also at South Leicestershire College and my chosen subject is The England Football team and its ill-fated Euro 2016 campaign
- Harvey: You will have one minute and thirty seconds on your chosen subject of The England football team and its ill-fated Euro 2016 campaign. And if you don't know an answer to a question then you must say pass so I can move on to the next question. Is that clear?
- Cont.2: I fully understand, can we begin?
- Harvey: Then we shall begin. Who was the previous England manager before Roy Hodgson took over?
- **Cont.2:** Was it that Italian person who was the previous manager
- Harvey: Close, but it was Fabio Capello
- **Cont.2:** But isn't Fabio Capello Italian?
- Harvey: Yes, that's correct

Score card adds one point [1]

Contestant one intervenes

- **Cont.1:** He/she didn't answer that question correctly
- Harvey: But he/she did correctly identify that Fabio Capello was Italian, I had to accept it, even the score card agreed
- **Cont.1:** But he/she should have said pass
- Harvey: Please return to your seat

Contestant one returns to the seat

- Harvey: Here is your next question. What formation did the then England Manager Roy Hodgson try in the last warmup match and was then used in Euro 2016?
- Cont.2: Pass
- Harvey: In their second game against Wales, who scored the first goal of that match?
- Cont.2: Gareth Bale

Contestant one intervenes again

- **Cont.1:** But are you sure it was Gareth Bale. It was another Wales player that took that goal during the free kick...
- Harvey: But technically he/she is correct

Score card adds another point [2]

Contestant one returns back to the seat

- Harvey: Here is your next question. What else did centre forward Harry Kane do during England's campaign?
- **Cont.2:** Shooting the ball into the net
- Harvey: Incorrect, Harry Kane was also taking corner kicks
- **Cont.2:** Strange place for a centre forwarder, are you sure it was Harry Kane?

Harvey: Yes that's correct

Score card adds point number 3 [3]

Contestant one intervenes again

Cont.1: He/she hasn't answer that question correctly again

Harvey: But I did say it was correct

Scorecard adds point number 4 [4]

- **Cont.1:** But he/she should have said pass, even I knew it was Harry Kane taking the corner kicks
- Harvey: Will you stop arguing, a person of your manor should constrain yourself, where were you taught again
- Cont.1: South Leicestershire College

Cont.2: Didn't he/she say South Leicestershire College

Harvey: Yes that's correct (Point 5)

Score card updates again [5]

- **Cont.1:** What kind of game you are running here, he/she has five points now, wait, how on earth did he/she get that fifth point.
- Harvey: I must have said correct again.

Scoreboard updates again [6]

- **Cont.1:** That scoreboard updated again!
- Harvey: Ops, I will make sure I do not say it again
- **Cont.1:** You'd better
- Harvey: Now return to your seat

Contestant one returns to the seat

- Harvey: Now where was I with the next question? How many goals did Joe Hart concede during the match against Iceland?
- **Cont.2:** Was it four goals
- Harvey: Incorrect, Joe Hart conceded two goals
- Harvey: Next Question. Which player made history...

The end bleeps cut Harvey off

- Harvey: I've started, so I will finish. Which player made history by scoring his first ever tournament goal?
- **Cont.2:** I think it is either Jamie Vardy or Daniel Sturridge
- Harvey: Correct, it was Jamie Vardy
- Scoreboard adds point seven [7]
- Contestant one intervenes again
- **Cont.1:** He/She gave two answers, surly that's not allowed
- Harvey: But I did accept the first correct answer that was said

Scoreboard adds point eight [8]

- **Cont.1:** But he/she should have said one of the answers, that scoreboard has changed AGAIN!
- Harvey: For the last time, please return to your seat or I will have to disqualify you

Contestant one returns to the seat

Harvey: So we come to the end of your round and somehow you got eight correct answers, one incorrect answer, and one pass which I will tell you the answer was the four, three, three formation. You finish the round with eight points. This means that our Mastermind Champion of 2016 is (Contestants name).

Contestant one intervenes again

Cont.1: This isn't fair, you gave me hard questions and I gave you proper answers, he/she shouldn't have deserved to be crowned Mastermind Champion...

Before Contestant one complains any further, Harvey ends the show

Harvey: And that is all we have time for, we will be back again in 2017, so goodnight
