SCRIPT - The Bank

Setting - The Bank meeting room

DAVE:

Please take a seat while I log in to my computer, my name is Mr. Fetcher but you can call me Dave

Hardy taking his seat

DAVE :

You can pitch out your idea when ready

HARDY:

My Name is Hardy Dunn and my plan is to extend my computer shop, so I'm seeking a £100,000.00 investment to pay for the extension

Dave typing this all into the computer when disaster strikes

DAVE:

WHAT! That was not supposed to do that

HARDY:

What has happened Dave?

DAVE:

My Computer has crashed and I have lost the notes I was taking while you was doing your pitch

HARDY:

Is there anything I can do?

DAVE:

Leave it to me, I know what I'm doing

HARDY:

I could call my computer repair man

DAVE:

You can't do that here, you're not allowed to use a mobile phone in this branch, did you say your computer repair man, wait, don't I know you by any chance, Hardy?

HARDY:

What are you on about?

DAVE:

I visited your computer shop so my Windows 10 Laptop can be fixed

HARDY:

My Expert did fix your computer and reported that it was working again

DAVE:

Your so-called computer repair man installed Windows 98 onto my laptop, and it's still not working as yet!!!

HARDY:

So what's happened to your office computer?

DAVE:

HARDY:

DAVE:

HARDY:

I'll get my repair man to fix this ASAP

Narrator:

So with that dealt with, Mr. Fetcher now discusses about Hardy's business plan

DAVE:

So tell me about your plan

HARDY:

I was going to make a small extension for the repair shop area so we can fix more computers

DAVE:

And what about the shop

HARDY:

It will still be the same

DAVE:

Well, if you are thinking of only extending the repair shop then it's not worth investing with you, you expect me to invest £100,000 into your business that destroyed my laptop!

HARDY:

But I could extend the shop and make it more ...

Dave cuts Hardy off

DAVE :

I have made my decision and I won't be investing with you, so I'm out.

Narrator:

Hardy has failed to get the investment he needs, and leaves with nothing
